



In my former parishes there would always be a charity collection over Lent and I hope that we can be just as generous here at St Paul's with collecting monies for a charity that provides sanitation in some of the poorest countries of the world. As one of our link Dioceses is the Democratic Republic of Congo, I'm encouraging all our parish groups and organisations to raise monies to twin a toilet in DRC– thus helping to fund a project in a community that will enable families to build a basic toilet, have access to clean water and learn about hygiene – a vital combination that saves lives. It costs £60 to twin a toilet and we will be sent a certificate to hang in our loo – showing a photograph of our overseas toilet twin and GPS coordinates so we can look up our twin's location on Google Maps! It would be great to twin all our toilets– thanks to Kidsrock preschool we made a good start with raising monies for both toilet twinning and Ukraine appeal– but we've only got half a toilet so far!
